RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Team rosters are limited to a maximum of eighteen (18) players & four (4) staff members. No more than 22 members per delegation are allow.
2. Players must have jersey numbers assigned and may not change numbers once registration is complete.
3. Any color conflicts regarding uniforms will be resolved by coin toss to decide which team will wear bibs.
4. All participant teams are required to present passports at registration. Birth certificates allow for USA citizens only if player don't have valid passport.
5. All matches will be full length as IFAB rules.
6. COMPETITION FORMAT
 - a. FOUR (4) TEAM SCENARIO: Tournament will host four (4) team (male / female). Each team will play each other once (three games guaranteed). The team with most points will win the tournament. All wins will add 3 points, a tie will add 1 point, and no points will be awarded for a loss. No overtime will be played if final score is tied. No penalties will be kicked to decide a game. In the event a tie breaker is necessary to determine final positions, the following order of tie breakers will apply:
 - goal difference in overall competition
 - highest gross goals scored in overall competition.
 - head to head competition
 - least amount of penalty points (caution = 1 point, sendoff = 2 points)
 - Tournament Manager's decision

- b. EIGHT (8) TEAM SCENARIO: Tournament will host a maximum of eight teams (male / female). A draw will sort teams into two (2) groups of four (4) (Group A / Group B).

GROUP STAGE: Each team will play each other once in their respective group.

FINAL ROUND: Matches for final round will be as follow:

1st GROUP A vs. 1st GROUP B: Will play the championship game

2nd GROUP A vs. 2nd GROUP B: Will play 3rd Place Match

3rd GROUP A vs. 3rd GROUP B: Will play Consolation Game

4th GROUP A vs. 4th GROUP B: Will play Consolation Game

All teams are guaranteed four matches. All wins will add 3 points, a tie will add 1 point, and no points will be awarded for a loss. No overtime will be played if final score is tied. Penalties will be kicked to decide a game in FINAL ROUND matches only. In the event a tie breaker is necessary to determine final positions, the following order of tie breakers will apply:

- goal difference in overall competition
 - highest gross goals scored in overall competition.
 - head to head match
 - least amount of penalty points (caution = 1 point, sendoff = 2 points)
 - Tournament Manager's decision
7. Free substitution is not permitted. A maximum of seven (7) substitutions will be allow during a match in a three-frame period. A maximum of three (3) substitutions are allow in each frame period. Usage of halftime to substitute players won't count as a frame period.
 8. The official match report for each completed match must be verified (i.e., score, cautions, send offs) immediately after the match by the team coach or manager. Match reports that are not verified stand as submitted and may not be contested or appealed.
 9. Players or Coaches sent off during a match are not allowed to play/coach in the next match.
 10. Judgment calls by referees may not be appealed.
 11. Tournament Manager's decisions may not be appealed.
 12. NO PROTESTS ALLOW IN THIS TOURNAMENT
 13. Subject to the foregoing, IFAB laws, as modified in this document, apply.
 14. In the event of weather issues, games that have completed the first half will be considered complete games and will not be rescheduled. All other game situations will be solved to be play if weather and field conditions permit (this may require modifications on game schedule and times to be play. All rescheduling/game time modifications will be made by Tournament Manager & FPF competition personnel. All decision will be final & may not be appealed.
 15. All team delegates/coaches will be responsible for players/staff misconducts.
 16. Decisions made by Tournament Manager & FPF Competition personnel on any matter is final and may not be appealed.
